ANNUAL REPORT OF THE COLLEGE FOR THE YEAR 2020-2021

Dr. B R Parineetha, Associate Professor. Department of history, the previous principal of the institution served till 30th September 2021. However from 1st July 2021 Dr.Y.C. Kamala, Associate Professor. Department of Physics took over the charge as the principal of the college.

Academic activities for even semester from April 2021:

The Governing Body Meeting was last held on 1st February, 2021. The Even semester classes started from April 2021, online mode due to nationwide COVID -19 lockdown. However the offline classes as prescribed by authorities, on a regular basis commenced from August 2021 onwards. The permitted activities in the college were being carried out with SOP prescribed by the government authorities.

Activities during the lockdown:

The college conducted extensive online classes during the lockdown period. The students took internal tests and submitted assignments online. PPT assignments were presented and uploaded to the college software by all the students of UG and PG. The same have been corrected and the reports were made ready for further process as per UGC guidelines. The details of online classes were reported to the university as and when desired by them.

Examinations and Results:

The End (Even) Semester Examination, September 2021 was conducted for the final year outgoing students as instructed by MHRD / UGC / GOK / University. The fourth and second semester student results were determined on the basis of the new guidelines provided by the said authorities. The college software was customized to the new guidelines.

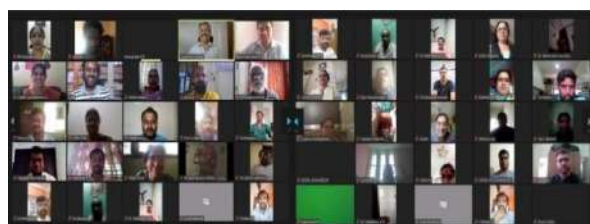

A Five Day Webinar series for teachers on **Exploring ICT Initiatives in Higher Education** was organised by **IQAC, National College, Jayanagar** from **13th to 17th July , 2020**. The response was well recognized with the registration of **391** participants from various colleges and universities. The webinar was e- inaugurated by **Dr. K.R. Venugopal**, Vice Chancellor of Bangalore University. The webinar was presided over by **Dr. A.H. Rama Rao**, the President, National Education Society of Karnataka who introduced the Chief Guest and welcomed the delegates. **Prof. S. Nagaraja Reddy**, the secretary, NES of Karnataka addressed the participants emphasising on the importance of ICT skills. The chief guest expressed his happiness to deliver inaugural address and congratulated the organisers for conducting an appropriate webinar.

The chief guest, **Dr. K.R. Venugopal** (himself being an computer trained taught computer skill at various levels...). He emphasized on seven golden principles of life like yoga, meditation, pranayama, walk, good food, sleep and good thoughts. Not only did he stress upon the significant role played by ICT in the new age of virtual reality, importance of digital library for self pace mode of learning and AI driven class room but also insisted the teaching fraternity to acquire knowledge and skill to transform the archaic mode of learning to virtual mode. A glimpse of digitised platforms initiated by MHRD was also given. The session was very interactive with the active participation of all the participants.

Dr. S.M. Shiva Prasad, Director, Higher Education Academy, Government of Karnataka was invited as the Chief Resource person for the day two of the webinar. He mainly focused on the three characteristics to be possessed by the teachers, important parameters of teaching and the three qualities to be taught to the students. Advantages of Online teaching were suggested by the chief resource person to motivate the teachers to turn the adversity into an opportunity. The speaker encouraged the teachers to understand the psychology of young adolescent students and strive hard like knowledge warriors to restructure every aspect of the society as it can happen only in the classroom. The session was highly interactive.

Prof. B.Manjunath, Co-ordinator, Jnananidhi You Tube channel, Department of Collegiate Education, Bangalore was invited as the Chief Resource person for the day 3 of webinar series who is the coordinator of Five different You Tube Channels of GOK. Through Sadhana Academy you tube channel prof. B. Manjunath has reached more than 6 lakhs viewers with videos on a wide range of topics from history to subtler subjects like mental ability. The speaker acquainted the participants about various Audio Video Tools in e-learning. He also highlighted the prerequisites of making effective videos like clarity in audio and video, light management, presentation and usage of editing soft wares. The participants were also informed of different interactive and evaluation platforms available. He emphasized on importance of presentation

skills while teaching online as the teachers should teach in front of camera in 'No Man's Land'. The delegates were also informed of various applications to make videos using computers and mobiles. The session was very informative which triggered many questions from participants.

Dr. B.L. Muralidhar, Associate Professor, Department of Computer Science, Bangalore University was the Chief Resource person for the day 4 of webinar series who highlighted on how ICT has transformed the present education system from chalk and talk method to digitalisation. The speaker stressed upon the benefits of SWAYAM and encouraged the teaching fraternity to get enrolled to the various courses available on different platforms. He insisted the teachers to make the best use of different platforms available for organising conferences and online classes to uplift the students academically. The session was very interactive as many questions were posed by participants during Q&A session.

Dr. M.K. Sridhar, President, Centre for Education and Social Studies (CESS), Bangalore took out his valuable time to address the delegates in the valedictory session of five day webinar series with the theme, Learning and ICT skills. The speaker motivated the delegates with his insightful thoughts in an interactive style and encouraged to adopt technology and blend it in teaching in an effective way which is the need of the hour.

Participants shared their impressions regarding the webinar series. They whole heartedly congratulated the organising team for conducting such an outstanding webinar with efficient resource persons. 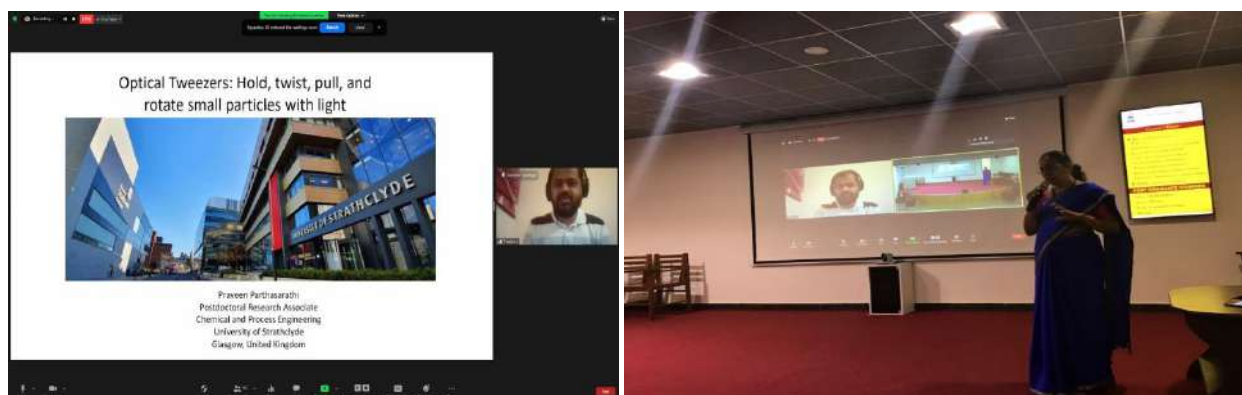


Department of Physics:

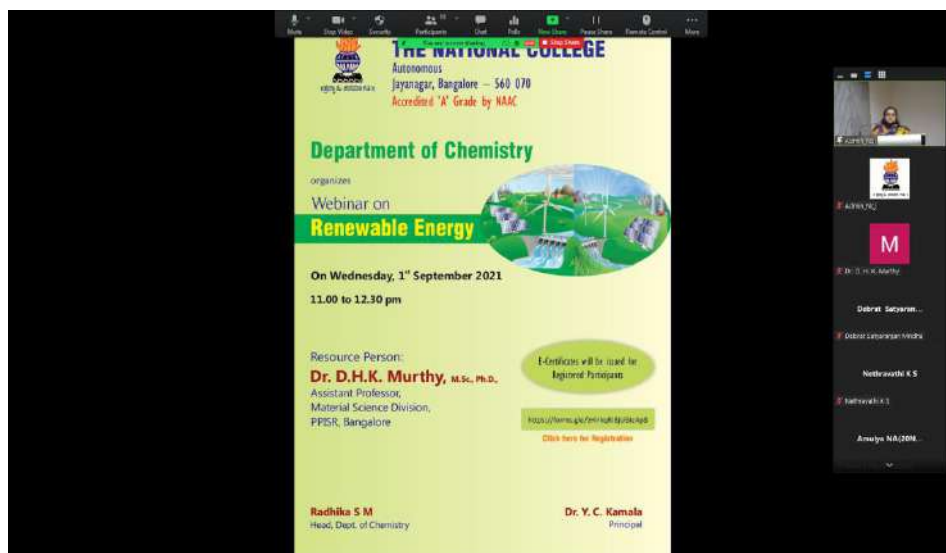
Department of Chemistry
