Administrative action in the event of ragging in our college: -

Depending on the nature and gravity of the guilt established by the Anti-Ragging Squad, award, to those found guilty, one or more of the following punishments, namely:

- 1. Suspension from attending classes and academic privileges.
- 2. Withholding/withdrawing scholarship/fellowship and other benefits.
- 3. Debarring from appearing in any test/examination or other evaluation process.
- 4. Withholding results.
- 5. Debarring from representing the institution in any regional, national or international meet, tournament, youth festival, etc.
- 6. Suspension/expulsion from the hostel.
- 7. Cancellation of admission.
- 8. Rustication from the institution for a period ranging from one to four semesters.
- 9. Expulsion from the institution and consequent debarring from admission to any other institution for a specified period. Provided that where the persons committing or abetting the act of ragging is not identified, the institution shall resort to collective punishment.

We had conducted the **ANTI RAGGING AWARENESS PROGRAMME** for the freshers of this academic year 2021-22. We have addressed the students and briefed them about the different strategies and action plan for curbing the menace of Ragging in the college by adopting various measures and activities. We have prominently displayed posters on our college campus, especially in the areas where students generally assemble.

The students of The National College, Jayanagar are hereby warned that they shall not indulge in "RAGGING". If they are found guilty of ragging they are liable for the above

mentioned punishment. Students are therefore requested to refrain from indulging in any kind of ragging.

NCJ campus is ragging free, still all these measures have been taken to ensure that the freshers are able to pursue their studies without getting teased, insulted or in any way troubled by the seniors in the name of an obsolete, barbaric ritual. All of this was possible only because of the whole-hearted support from students and teachers.
