- 1) The previous BOS of 08th June 2017 was thoroughly reviewed and discussed. The changes were incorporated and the chairman explained the changes.
- 2) As per UGC guidelines and NAAC requirements, The Department of Commerce prepared for B.Com course the **Program Educational Objectives (PEO), Program Outcomes (PO) and the Program Specific Outcomes (PSO)** in its proper format from academic year 2018 onwards.

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
- 3) The Board discussed and resolved to approve the B.Com PEO, PO & PSO as stated above.
- 4) The Board discussed and securitized regulations & scheme under CBCS.
- 5) The Board reviewed and resolved to approve the pattern of examination question paper as mentioned in the regulation and scheme of study.
- 6) From the academic year 2018 onwards, a new subject ^{was} is proposed with title "Business Marketing" replacing the ^{earlier} subject titled "Retail Management" keeping in view its objectives and relevance in I semester.
- 7) ^{However,} The Board ^{recommended to change the title} discussed and resolved to approve the change in the ^{title} subject of "~~Retail Management~~" with "~~Business Marketing~~". ^{the subject is "Fundamentals of Marketing"}
- 8) The chairman readout the syllabus of newly introduced subject titled "~~Business Marketing~~" and the board discussed and resolved to approve the syllabus.
- 9) In the subject "Financial Accounting" in I semester, ^{and suggested few changes} the syllabus is modified by replacing a module to keep the students understanding into consideration.
- 10) The Board agreed and resolved to approve the change in the "Financial Accounting" in I semester.
- 11) In the II semester it is proposed with a new subject titled "Indian Financial System" replacing the existing subject titled "Services Management" keeping in view the basic understanding of our financial system in II semester.
- 12) The Board discussed and resolved to approve the change in the subject of "Services Management" with "Indian Financial System".
- 13) The chairman readout the syllabus of newly introduced subject titled "Indian Financial System" and the board discussed and resolved to approve the syllabus.
- 14) In the subject "Advanced Financial Accounting" in II semester, the syllabus is modified by replacing a module to give the students an enhanced aspect of accounting.

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- 15) The Board resolved to approve for continuation of the same inter disciplinary papers for III & IV semester non – commerce students.
- 16) As per the statute of Autonomous, the External Board of Examiners (BOE) should be constituted in the BOS meeting with the consent of the members of the BOS. The list of external BOE was read out and shown by the Chairman of BOS for selection and approval. The Board resolved to approve eight members from the panel of BOE.
- 17) The Board members strongly recommended starting of any specialized or integrated B.Com course and also recommended for any good certificate course like E-banking, Tourism Management, Supply Chain Management, Big Data and Competitive Market Positioning etc.
- 18) Finally, the Chairman thanked the members and the members reciprocated the same to him.


