#### **Introduction:**

Dr. B R Parineetha, Associate Professor. Department of history, the previous principal of the institution served till 30<sup>th</sup> September 2021. However from 1st July 2021 Dr.Y.C. Kamala, Associate Professor. Department of Physics took over the charge as the principal of the college.

### Academic activities for even semester from April 2021:

The Governing Body Meeting was last held on 1st February, 2021. Academic Council Meeting 2<sup>nd</sup> December 2021, Governing Body Meeting on 7the December 2021 and Finance Committee Meeting on 14the February 2021. The Even semester classes started from April 2021, Through online mode due to nationwide COVID -19 lockdown. However the offline classes as prescribed by authorities, on a regular basis commenced from August 2021 onwards. The permitted activities in the college were being carried out with SOP prescribed by the government authorities.

#### Activities during the lockdown:

The college conducted extensive online classes during the lockdown period. The students took internal tests and submitted assignments online. PPT assignments were presented and uploaded to the college software by all the students of UG and PG. The same have been corrected and the reports were made ready for further process as per UGC guidelines. The details of online classes were reported to the university as and when desired by them.

#### **Examinations and Results:**

The End (Even) Semester Examination, September 2021 was conducted for the final year outgoing students as instructed by MHRD / UGC / GOK / University. The fourth and second semester student results were determined on the basis of the new guidelines provided by the said authorities. The college software was customized to the new guidelines. Odd Semester Classes Started from 4<sup>th</sup> October 2021 for PG Odd Semester Classes started form 1<sup>st</sup> December 2021.

The Previous Governing Body Meeting was last held on 25<sup>th</sup> July 2022. The Academic Council Meeting was last held on 4<sup>th</sup> July 2022 and the Finance committee meeting was held on 9<sup>th</sup> February 2022. The Even Semester classes started from 25<sup>th</sup> April 2022 through the offline mode. The permitted activities in the College were being carried out with SOP prescribed by the Government authorities.




# Release of College Magazine Srujana:

## **Campus Walk**







#### Physics Competition on My Favorite Scientist/ Technologist



# Report on the Golden Eye: James Webb Space Telescope Webinar


Department of Physics National College Jayanagar with the collaboration of Karnataka Science and Technology Academy (KSTA) had conducted a webinar "The Golden Eye: James Webb Space Telescope" on 24th Jan 2022. This educative webinar was delivered by **Dr Priya Hasan** Physics Professor from Maulana Azad National Urdu University Hyderabad. Quiet large number of participants attended this webinar and gained lots of knowledge about James Webb Telescope. The speaker emphasized that it is a project led by the United States National Aeronautics and Space Administration (NASA), with major contributions from the European and Canadian Space Agencies (ESA and CSA). It will have an approximately 6.6 m diameter aperture, will be passively cooled to below 50 K, and will carry four scientific instruments: a Near-IR Camera(NIRCam), a Near-IR Spectrograph (NIRSpec), a near-IR Tunable Filter Imager(TFI), and a Mid-IR Instrument (MIRI). The spacecraft will carry enough fuel for a 10 yr mission and worth of \$11-billion Webb telescope aims to probe the early Universe. Its main objectives are to end the dark ages, observe galaxies, understand the birth of stars etc. The speaker elaborated on these topics and also quickly gave a glimpse of other telescopes as well and set a great platform and beautifully delivered the lecture and concluded the webinar.




#### Webinar on Science and Economy


#### **Report On Chemistry Poster Presentation Competition**







#### Following topics were covered in the workshop




present the same on the stage. More than 25 students participated in this and 11 students presented their papers and it was lively and interactive session, students enjoyed learning by discussion.








### **ACTIVITIES OF NSS:**


# **Department of Physical Education and Sports Science:**


# 05<sup>th</sup> June 2022- Sunday






## **Annual Athletic Meet:**







# **College Day:**

## **Day 1:**

The FDP started with the inaugural talk by **Dr.A.H.Rama Rao**, President of National Education Society. The program started by delivering the agenda and objective of the FDP program by the president.



The session began by introduction to key concepts of machine learning, supervised learning and unsupervised learning concepts, problem identification, choosing right algorithm, tuning parameters, and validating a model.

#### **Day 2:**

The second day of FDP included, understanding train and test data splits, K-Nearest Neighbors, train test splits and cross validation. Implementation of Linear Regression, Regularization and Gradient Descent algorithm using Python Jupyter Notebook environment.

#### **Day 3:**

Classification concepts were explained along with the execution of logistic regression algorithm. Classification algorithms Support Vector Machine, Decision tree were discussed along with the classification error metrics.

#### **Day 4:**

Unsupervised learning method Clustering was discussed in the session. Clustering algorithms were implemented. Introduction was given to Deep Learning and its applications with real world examples.

#### **Day 5:**

Session was devoted to explaining the concepts, terminologies, techniques, mathematics of Deep Learning. The training discussed the fundamental neural network architectures, feed forward and convolution and recurrent networks. The session gave an understanding of building and training a model using MNIST and CIFAR-10 dataset. Image classification and data augmentation using hands on E2E workflow was covered in the session.

# **Day 6:**

The last day session was learning about intel Distribution of OpenVino toolkit for DL inference. Using multiple models in one application was discussed. Hands on session was provided for object detection, classification and style transfer using OpenVino toolkit. Real World use cases such as Healthcare, Industry and Retail applications were explained and practice exercises for each was provided.
