## PROCEEDINGS OF THE UG BOS MEETING OF B.COM (HONS) PROGRAMME HELD ON FRIDAY, 21<sup>st</sup> NOVEMBER 2022

- 1. The Chairman welcomed all the BOS members of the B.Com, UG Department BoS meeting.
- 2. The Board discussed and scrutinized the regulations and scheme under CBCS in par with the norms of *NEP 2020*.
- 3. The subject experts of BoS highlighted the importance in implementing the salient features of National Education Policy 2020, in the UG curriculum and urged all the department members to adopt the innovative and goal oriented curriculum structure that would enable the students to have a successful career and become responsible citizens.
- 4. In line with instructions of the University Representative Dr. K Nirmala Reddy, the course content and syllabi of the *Discipline Specific Core Courses* viz.,

III Semester B.Com: Corporate Accounting, Business Mathematics & Statistics (or) Indian Financial Services and Company Law & Administration

**IV Semester B.Com**: Advanced Corporate Accounting, Cost Accounting & Business Regulations- were to be retained in line with syllabi of JB Campus - Bangalore University. *Conducting of practical classes* to be converted to one hour theory for III SEM Corporate Accounting & IV SEM Advanced Corporate Accounting & Cost Accounting the Board members strongly recommended having *Open Elective Course – Entrepreneurship Skills (or) Investment in Stock markets to* Non – Commerce Students.

- 5. The Board members appreciated the conducting of Skill Enhancement Course III & IV Semester - Value Based III semester: Financial Education & Investment Awareness IV Semester: Artificial Intelligence
- 6. The members of the Board appreciated, resolved and approved the initiative of the college in collaboration with all the departments to offer and conduct Value Based Course NCC/NSS/R&R/S&G/Cultural(Music/Dance/Drama)

- 7. The Board resolved and approved to retain the **Lecture + Theory + Practical hours** applicable for all the courses as mentioned in the course matrix of the University syllabus.
- 8. The Board reviewed and resolved to approve the pattern of *Internal Test and End Semester Examination question paper pattern* as mentioned in the Regulation and Scheme of Study.
- 9. Also the Board reviewed and resolved to approve the norms and procedure to score student *Continuous Internal Evaluation* as mentioned in the Regulation and Scheme of Study. They emphasized on <u>No Minimum</u> in respect of student Continuous Internal Evaluation in par with NEP 2020.
- 10. The Board strongly recommended holding on to the *allocation of credits* in accordance with Bangalore University in par with NEP 2020.
- 11. The list of external BoE was read out by the Chairman of the BoS for selection and approval. The board resolved to *approve nine members from the panel of BoE*.
- 12. The Board members strongly recommended good certificate *Add on Courses/Value Added Courses* like E- Filing; Research Methodology; Supply Chain Management; Big Data; Competitive Marketing Positioning; Leadership Courses; Business Development Training and so on for which certificates will be given. The Board also urged to compulsorily conduct a *certificate course from external sources to first year* students to strengthen their basics in commerce related courses.
