The Board discussed the pattern of the question papers and suggested the existing pattern to the academic year 2022-23.

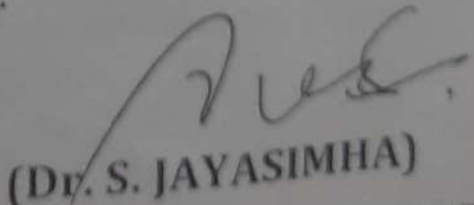
The Board also discussed about the members to be included in BOE for the academic year 2021-22 and approved the following list of members:

Press notes 2, Speech Reporting 2, Protest 2, Accidents 2, Obituary 2, disaster 2, Communal riots 2, Political Reporting 2, election 2, Legislature 2 etc.

Note: Each student shall compulsorily maintain assignments and record book, submit the Same at the end of the semester in the form of Project Report.
