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- The Chairman welcomed all the BoS members of the B.Com, UG Department BoS meeting.
- The Board discussed and scrutinized the regulations and scheme under CBCS in par with the norms of NEP 2020.
- 3. The subject experts of BoS highlighted the importance in implementing the salient features of National Education Policy 2020, in the UG curriculum and urged all the department members to adopt the innovative and goal oriented curriculum structure that would enable the students to have a successful career and become responsible citizens.
- 4. In line with instructions of the University Representative Dr. k Nirmala Reddy, the course content and syllabus of the Discipline Specific Core Courses viz., Advanced Financial Accountancy, Business Ethics and Banking Innovation was to be retained in according to syllabus of JB Campus Bangalore University. Conduction of practical classes (E Treatment of Accountancy with Spread Sheet) in Business lab or Commerce lab for Advanced Financial Accountancy was insisted upon for the betterment of student skills.
- 5. The Board members strongly recommended having *Open Elective Course* E-Commerce to *Non Commerce Students* and Business Documents to *Commerce Students*. They were of an opinion and later strongly insisted *to promote Commerce students to take up commerce open elective course* only.
- The Board discussed and resolve to approve the syllabus of Open Elective Course – Insurance Management System exclusively for B.C.A (Data Science), IoT and B.Sc (Bio – Medical).
- The Board members discussed and resolved to conduct Skill Enhancement Course - Skill Based Course, Spreadsheet for Business on full-fledged basis including both lecture and practical sessions.
- 8. The members of the Board appreciated, resolved and approved the syllabus framed for Skill Enhancement Course – EVS/ICHR. On a serious note, the Board urged the department members to confirm active participation of all the students in the said courses.

- The Board resolved and approved to retain the Lecture + Theory + Practical hours applicable for all the courses as mentioned in the course matrix of the University syllabus.
- 10. The Board reviewed and resolved to approve the pattern of Internal Test and End Semester Examination question paper pattern as mentioned in the Regulation and Scheme of Study.
- 11. Also the Board reviewed and resolved to approve the norms and procedure to score student *Continuous Internal Evaluation* as mentioned in the Regulation and Scheme of Study. They emphasized on *No Minimum* in respect of student Continuous Internal Evaluation in par with NEP 2020.
- The Board strongly recommended holding on to the allocation of credits in accordance with Bangalore University in par with NEP 2020.
- 13. As per the statute of Autonomous, the External Board of Examiners (BOE) should be constituted in the BoS meeting with the consent of the members. The list of external BoE was read out by the Chairman of the BoS for selection and approval. The board resolved to approve nine members from the panel of BoE.
- 14. The Board members presented their views on the curriculum structure and finalized with the consensus of all the members and duly accepted by the Chairman.
- 15. Based on the recommendation of the members of the BoS, the Chairman resolved and accepted the new scheme of teaching, evaluation and curriculum from the academic year 2021-22 onwards, based on National Educational Policy 2020 for 4 year B.Com(Hon.) Under Graduate Programme.
- 16. The Board members strongly recommended good certificate Add on Courses/Value Added Courses like E- Filing; Research Methodology; Supply Chain Management; Big Data; Competitive Marketing Positioning; Leadership Courses; Business Development Training and so on.
- 17. The Board urged to compulsorily conduct a certificate course from external sources to first year students to strengthen their basics in commerce related courses.

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Finally, the Chairman thanked the members and the members reciprocated the same to him.
