I ACTIVITIES OF IOAC:

• A Faculty Development program on Internet as a Link between Language and Literature was organized on 29th September 2022. Kamala welcomed all the participants, introduced the resource person and briefly highlighted the importance of internet as a bridge between language and literature. The resource person mainly focused on the significance of book digitization in the current era which can go a long way not only in helping the research scholars and writers protect copyrights of their works but also with increased access and achieve cost efficiency. He stressed upon the process of book

digitization like proper file scanning, data entry and quality control which can work wonders in ensuring that one can tackle any challenge that might arise in modern day.

The IQAC of the college required a wheel chair for the institution so as to use in case of medical exigency to the faculty members and students Dr. P L Venkatarama Reddy, The Chairman of The National College Jayanagar, has been considerate to donate the wheel chair. The Principal expressed gratitude for his timely, kind hearted support.



A One Day Awareness Programme on Drug Abuse Prevention, Celebrating Life was organized by the IQAC of the National College, Jayanagar in collaboration with MAYA on 25th April, 2023 in BVJ Science Centre to create awareness among the students about the ill-effects of drug consumption. Mr. S.J. Chander, Founder, CEO, Foundation for Sustainable Health India (FSHI), Consultant, MAYA Health and Dr. Shalini Thakur, Health Care Global (HCG), Cancer Centre, Bengaluru were the resource persons. Mr. S.J. Chander, in his speech informed the students that India sees 13,00,000 deaths every year due to the consumption of drugs. Dr. Shalini Thakur spoke ill effects of drug and alcohol consumption citing various examples. Mr. Githin Chandra, the Manager of MAYA gave a brief introduction to drug abuse as a social evil and its impact on youth. He reiterated that youth group forms the major stakeholder for tobacco control as tobacco companies are marketing their products targeting youth and they form a major customer base to replace the 13 lakhs customer who succumbed to tobacco related deaths every year. So he motivated the students to write a letter addressing the Prime Minister of India mentioning the following points:

- a. Make public places 100% smoke free so that innocent people are saved from harms of tobacco.
- b. Ban all forms of tobacco advertisements and promotions including at point of sale.
- c. Increase the penalties for violations of COTPA laws to act as a deterrent.
- d. Ban sales of single stick cigarettes making it non-affordable to youth.

Dr. B. Suresh, the Principal of the college gave welcome address and introduced the resource persons and Dr. Vijayalakshmi, IQAC Coordinator proposed vote of thanks. The NCC cadets and NSS volunteers actively participated in the programme.





Orientation Programme on Civil Service Examinations



1. Department of Commerce:





A Debate Competition was organised on 15th November 2022 on the topic *Is India developing or developed?* The students had varied and interesting opinions about the same.




An Impromptu Competition was organised on 16th November 2022 which enhanced students' quick thinking abilities and measured their creative response.

The Department of Collegiate & Technical Education – GOK had organised an online program to commemorate the National Science Day on 28th February 2023. As part of the program,


