### MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

between

The National College-Autonomous

and

Florida International University

This Memorandum of Understanding («MOU") is entered into on the 9th day of May, 2016 (the "Effective Date," which shall be the date this MOU is fully executed), by and between the The National College-Autonomous, (hereafter referred to as "NCA") located in Basavanagudi, Bangalore, India, and The Florida International University Board of Trustees, on behalf of the College of Engineering and Computing ("CEC") at Florida International University (hereafter referred to as "FIU"), a member of the State University System of the State of Florida; FIU is located in Miami, Florida, United States of America ("USA"). NCA and FIU agree to explore the possibility of developing the highest quality programs to advance the needs of NCA and FIU. NCA and FIU are hereafter collectively referred to as the "Parties".

### Introduction

In order to facilitate the implementation of specific activities of educational cooperation and research, as well as develop contacts between academic staff and students from both institutions, FIU and NCA will examine collaborative avenues of opportunities. To realize this goal, both FIU and NCA recognize the following commonalities:

- 1. The compatibility of the direction and interest of their teaching and research;
- 2. The significant roles they each play as leaders in higher education, teaching and research within their respective countries; and
- 3. The knowledge and exchange with appropriate industries for product development and patent recognition.

### **Exploration of Collaboration**

FIU and NCA aspire to sign an MOU as a way to develop a collaborative relationship based on the following:

- The possibility of research collaboration in specific areas identified by both Parties. The proposed plan under consideration involves assistance in guiding research projects, faculty and scholar exchange, and publication of research papers that culminate from collaborative research projects.
- The exploration of faculty visits to instruct in subjects identified by NCA and FIU. (Refer to Appendix A for more information.)
- The Parties will consider developing a collaboration to enable students from NCA and FIU to enroll in online courses or attend courses from each other's institution and acquire suitable credits towards their degree programs (subject to transfer credit policies of each Party).
- The possibility of planning and coordinating international conferences, seminars and symposia will be examined.
- The Parties will also consider the feasibility of publishing and editing electronic and printed documents that they have generated. The option to facilitate the exchange of information and academic materials in areas of mutual interest is subject to the US Export Administration Regulations (see below for the citation).
- Online certificate-based learning cooperation will also be explored, including models to deploy such learning.

Via the individuals listed below, the Parties will encourage contact and cooperation among their faculty members and departmental units. Both Parties agree to actively seek sponsorship from various local, national and international funding sources in support of such collaborative educational activities.

This MOU serves as an institutional framework for collaborative activities. Specific agreements would need to be drafted by the Parties in the case that the exploration of these areas leads to further developments. These agreements would need to be approved by authorities at each institution. Nothing in this MOU shall be construed as creating any legal relationship between the Parties.

This MOU is subject to the Constitution and laws of the USA and of the State of Florida and the regulations of the Florida Board of Governors and The Florida International University Board of Trustees. In particular, all the provisions of this MOU and any agreement to be derived therefrom must adhere to the requirements of Part 736 of the Export Control Administration regulations accessible through http://ecfr.gpoaccess.gov, and as they may be amended in the future. The Public Records Law applies to all aspects of this MOU.

Both Parties understand that financial arrangements under this MOU would have to be negotiated and would depend on specific activities and the availability of funds. Any expense incurred by either Party would be subject to individual agreements on a case-by-case basis. The Parties also recognize that intellectual property terms would need to be included in subsequent agreements, as appropriate. In addition, anyone teaching at FIU from NCA must have the approved credentials; FIU is accredited by the **Southern Association of Colleges** 

and Schools Commission on Colleges ("SACSCOC") and its faculty qualification guidelines represent commonly accepted good practice for the academic qualifications of faculty. Appendix A identifies the faculty qualifications required by FIU.

This MOU is non-exclusive and would become effective on the date of its final signing. The MOU could be renewed every three (3) years upon the mutual consent of the Parties. The MOU would be reviewed in one-and-a-half (4%) years to assess results.

This MOU may be amended or further developed by means of written consent on the part of the signatories or their designated representatives. The MOU may be terminated with at least 90 days' advance written notice. Notices must be sent to the individuals and addresses indicated below:

### Appendix A

### Qualified Faculty Requirements

The institution employs competent faculty members qualified to accomplish the mission and goals of the institution. When determining acceptable qualifications of its faculty, the institution gives primary consideration to the highest earned degree in the discipline.

The institution also considers competence, effectiveness, and capacity, including, as appropriate, undergraduate and graduate degrees, related work experience in the field, professional licensure and certifications, honors and awards, continuous documented excellence in teaching, or other demonstrated competencies and achievements that contribute to effective teaching and student learning outcomes.

Florida International University uses the following as credential guidelines when it defines faculty qualifications using faculty credentials:

Faculty teaching general education courses at the undergraduate level: doctorate or master's degree in the teaching discipline or master's degree with a concentration in the teaching discipline (a minimum of 18 graduate semester hours in the teaching discipline).

 Faculty teaching baccalaureate courses: doctorate or master's degree in the teaching discipline or master's degree with a concentration in the teaching discipline (a minimum of 18 graduate semester hours in the teaching discipline).

Faculty teaching graduate and post-baccalaureate course work: earned doctorate/terminal degree in the teaching discipline or a related discipline

 Graduate teaching assistants: master's in the teaching discipline or 18 graduate semester hours in the teaching discipline, direct supervision by a faculty member experienced in the teaching discipline, regular in-service training, and planned and periodic evaluations.

As a Carnegie Research University with High Research Activity (RU/H), Florida International University additionally credentials its faculty based on national/international juried research productivity within the discipline. The institution documents a faculty member's research contributions to the discipline as evidence of the faculty qualifications.

In extremely limited circumstances a faculty member may be credentialed based on a combination of educational experience, productivity in the discipline and work experience. In these situations the practical experience in the discipline must be at an executive level with a broad scope of national/international reach.





### 1. PURPOSE

The National college, JayanagarBangalore and R.V College of Engineering, Bengalurubelieve that the quality of education and research is strengthened by establishment of co-operation links and wish to enter into academic research collaboration with a view to their mutual enrichment in scientific, academic and engineering areas.

### 2. OBJECTIVES

The general objective of this memorandum of understanding is:

### 5. EXCHANGE OF RESEARCHERS

- a. The participation of any researcher from either institution in the exchange will be subject to the prior approval of such researcher by the institution.
- b. Each institutionundertakes to maintain the salary and supplementary benefits of its own faculty members who participate in the exchange, consistent with its faculty level policies and other policies in effect from time to time.
- c. Participants in the each of the institutions, while in attendance at the other institutions' facilities, shall abide by the rules and regulations of that host institutionregarding the use of facilities and conduct, and shall be subject to the policies, rules and regulations of the host institution.

### 6. RESEARCH PROGRAMME MANAGEMENT

Each institution shall appoint one (or, if appropriate, more than one) academics / research program coordinator to ensure that the academic /research co-operation proceeds according to reasonable plan and to ensure that the purposes, objectives and terms of this MoU are carried out. Each institution may at any time name a successor to, or replacement of, its research program coordinators). The coordinator thus appointed, shall periodically review and identify right of path to strengthen co-operation between the institutions.

### 7. INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

The National College, Jayanagar, Bangalore, and R.V. College of Engineering Bengaluruagree to respect each other's rights to intellectual property. Further, the intellectual property rights that arise as a result of collaborative research or activity under this MoU will be worked out on case to case basis, and will be consistent with officially laid down IPR policies of the two institutions. Parties agree and confirm that parties shall have copyright and all the intellectual property rights in respect of their own respective products. After prior written consent of the other party, parties can utilize each other's copyright, trademark or design only for the purpose of satisfaction of the objectives of this MoU only during the tenure of this MoU.

confidential information shall bear the copyright or propriety notices contained in the original. All the information obtained as a result of entering into or performing this MoU, shall be kept as confidential by both the parties, but shall be bound to be disclosed if needed by law or by judicial and/or statutory authorities. The confidentiality obligations shall survive the termination of this MoU.

- a) For the purpose of this section:
- i. "Intellectual Property" means, without limitation, any and all know how processes, technologies, software, specifications, drawings, flow charts, sketches, models, samples, technical or business information, inventions, discoveries, techniques, technical information and all related intellectual property rights worldwide arising under any law, and whether or not statutorily protected, including all
  - Patents, patent applications and patent rights
  - Copyright registration, copyright applications and copyright rights
  - Industrial design and industrial design application
  - Trademarks, trade marks applications, trade mark registrations and trademark rights
  - Rights relating to the protection of confidential information
  - Any other property rights relating to intangible property and divisions, continuations, renewals, reissues and extension of any of the above (as and to extent applicable) now existing or hereafter filed, issued or acquired.
- ii. "Project" means any of the collaborations including, but not limited to, a training, research or service delivery programme, project or subject area in which the parties collaborate or assist each other as contemplated by this MoU.
- iii. Where a provision to the effect that R. V. College of Engineering, Bengaluru owns any Intellectual Property (IP), such provision shall be read to mean R. V. College of Engineering, Bengaluru, or its Scientists, other employees or students that the participants in the project own such IP in accordance with its policies and any applicable collective agreement.
- (b) Unless the parties have otherwise agreed in writing with respect to a specific research program project prior to commencement of work on such project:
- i. All IP of the parties (and its third party licensors )and existed on the date of the commencement of the Project or that is subsequently created or acquired solely by any such institution in performing the work under the project shall be owned by the institution. The other party shall have a personal, non-exclusive right to use such Intellectual Property provided by the first named institution for the purpose of the project and for internal teaching and research purpose.
- li. Ownership of jointly developed Intellectual Property shall be determined by the participating parties on a project basis, having regard to the nature, quality and extent of the contributions by the respective parties.
- iii. Any commercialization of jointly developed intellectual property, including publication or other disclosure, shall be as determined in advance by the respective program coordinators of the contributing parties.

### 8. DURATION AND AMENDMENT OF AGREEMENT

This MoU shall have in effect the date it is signed by representatives of the two institutions and be in binding upon the parties here to for a period of five years from the date of MoU and may be continued after suitable review and agreement. Each institution respects that it has authority to enter into this

#### 9. INDEMNITY

R. V. College of Engineering, Bengaluru here agree to indemnify The National College, Jayanagar, Bangalore and keep its officers, employees harmless from and against all claims. Demands losses and damages penalties, expenses and proceedings connected with this MoU or arising from any breach in relation to any such provisions as aforesaid or breach of any terms and conditions of this agreement of otherwise arising from any act, commission, misrepresentations or omissions on R. V. College of Engineering, Bengaluru part, whether willful or not. This shall be in addition to any other remedy that University may have in terms of this agreement or under law of the land. All indemnities given by R. V. College of Engineering, Bengaluru shall survive the expiry or termination of this MoU.

### 10. EARLY TERMINATION.

This MoU may be terminated at any time upon the written mutual consent of the parties or upon either party giving three months written notice of the termination in advance. Once terminated, neither The National College, Jayanagar, Bangalorenor R. V. College of Engineering, Bengaluru will be responsible for the losses, financial or otherwise, which the other institution may suffer. However, The National College, Jayanagar, Bangalore and R. V.
