





(The Service Provider and the Institution are hereinafter, collectively referred to as the "Parties" and individually as a "Party".)

WHEREAS:

- The Service Provider is engaged in assisting various producers in complying with (A) extended producer responsibility and reverse logistics of end of life electrical and electronic components from various sources and channeling them to authoised recycler(s) as per the E-waste(Management) Rules, 2016("E-waste Rules") under the brand name of "Saahas Zero Waste":
- (B) The Institution is engaged in the business of Academics and Research; and
- The Parties have now agreed to enter into this Agreement to set forth the agreed terms (C) and conditions based on which the Service Provider will provide certain services to the Institution in relation to compliance under the E-waste Rules.

IT IS AGREED BY AND AMONGST THE PARTIES HERETO AS FOLLOWS

During the Term (as defined hereinafter) and in accordance with the terms of this Agreement, the Service Provider agrees to provide the following services to the Institution upon payment of the service fee set against the relevant service (collectively "Services").

2.	Collection of e-waste and channelisation to authorised recycler	Rs. 4,000

- Within two days from the Execution Date, the Service Provider shall submit to the Institution an invoice (the "Invoice") setting out the Service Fees for preparing annual returns and collection of E-waste and details of taxes, all of which shall be payable by the Institution in advance of completion of the Services.
- The Institution shall make payment of the Service Fee and the taxes quoted in the Invoice within 7 (seven) days from the date of receipt of the Invoice. It is agreed between the Parties that the Service Provider will provide the Services only after receipt of amount set out in the Invoice. In addition, in the event of any failure by the Institution to pay the Service Provider any of the amounts due under the terms of the Agreement within the agreed payment period, the Institution shall also be liable to pay interest on the monies owed to the Service Provider at a rate of 12% per annum, and such interest shall pegree accrue from the date of such monies first becoming due and payable to the Service

Provider till the actual date of payment.

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- Any and all sums payable under this Agreement including the Service Fee are exclusive of applicable taxes and shall be charged in addition to the Service Fee. Any amount payable by the Institution to the Service Provider shall be made in full without set-off or counter-claim and free from any deduction or withholding whatsoever, except as required by applicable laws.
- Each of the Parties represents and warrants to the other Party it has the legal right, power and authority to enter into, deliver and perform this Agreement. This Agreement when executed will constitute the legal, valid and binding obligations of the Party and is enforceable against such Party in accordance with its terms.
- The Service Provider agrees to indemnify, defend and hold the Institution and its representatives harmless against any and all actual damages which arise out of, or result from or may be payable by virtue of any default or breach by the Service Provider of any of its covenants and obligations under this Agreement. The liability of the Service Provider and/or its representatives to the Institution and/or its representatives for all claims under the Agreement (except in cases of penalties imposed by the authorities under the E-waste Rules on the Institution due to actions or omissions that can be solely attributed to the Service Provider) shall be limited to the Service Fee.
- Neither Party shall incur any liability due to failure or delay in performance of any obligation caused by Force Majeure, at least for the duration of the Force Majeure; provided, however, that the affected Party shall promptly notify the other of the existence of the Force Majeure and the effect on its ability to perform its obligations, and that the affected Party undertakes all reasonable efforts to mitigate the impact of the Force Majeure on the other Party. If any Force Majeure endures more than 60 (sixty) days, the Parties shall meet and review in good faith the desirability and conditions of this Agreement. "Force Majeure" for the purpose of this Agreement shall mean any event or circumstance or combination of events or circumstances that materially and adversely affects, prevents or delays any Party in the performance of its obligations in accordance with the terms of this Agreement, but only if and to the extent that such events and circumstances are not within the affected Party's control or was not foreseeable;
- This Agreement shall be valid for a period of1 (one) year from [April 6th 2021] ("Term"), unless terminated earlier in accordance with this Agreement. The Institutionmay terminate the Agreement, upon the breach, failure or refusal of the Service Provider to perform any term, covenant or condition of this Agreement, which breach, failure or refusal shall continue for 30 (thirty) days following written notice thereof by the Institution, specifying such default.
- 9. Upon termination or expiry of this Agreement, all rights granted and obligations created pursuant to this Agreement shall terminate and the Service Provider shall immediately discontinue the supply of the Services. Within 30 (thirty) calendar days from the date of termination, each Party shall return to the other all Confidential Information and all documents containing Confidential Information, reports and all other documents created in pursuance of this Agreement.
- 10. The Parties agree and undertake that they and their affiliates, directors, officers, employees and professional advisors shall not reveal, to any third Person other than the foregoing parties any Confidential Information without the prior written consent of the other Party, provided that a Party may disclose Confidential Information, if and to the extent: (i) required by applicable law; (ii) required by any governmental authority to which the Party making the disclosure is subject, whether or not such requirement has the force of law;(iii) the information has come into the public domain through no fault of the Party disclosing such information; or (iv) was already in the lawful possession of that

Party; (v) where other Party have given prior written approval to the means any and all material information of a Party, which has or may come into the National College AUTONOMICS OF Session or knowledge of the other Party in connection with or as a result of entering vanagar, Bangalore-70.

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- 11. All notices hereunder shall be given to the Parties at their respective addresses set forth above until a new and different address shall be established for either Party on the basis of notice given to the other Party. Any change in the communication address has to be informed to the other Party within 3 (three) days of the change.
- 12. This Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of India and the courts of Bangalore shall have exclusive jurisdiction.
- 13. The Institution grants the Service Provider the permission to use its logos and brand names in the Service Provider's literature such as brochures, information memorandum, client profiles and websites for the purpose of showcasing its business profile and clients.
- 14. The Parties acknowledge and agree that this Agreement constitutes the entire agreement and understanding between the Parties concerning their subject matter and supersedes any prior agreements or understandings concerning this subject matter.
- 15. Each of the Parties shall, at all times, act in good faith in the discharge of their obligations under this Agreement and not do anything which would constitute a contravention of its terms.
- 16. No amendments of this Agreement shall be binding on any Party unless such amendment is in writing and signed by each Party.
- 17. No Party may assign or transfer or sub-contract any of its rights, benefits or obligations under this Agreement without the prior written consent of the other Party.
- 18. If any part or all of any provision of this Agreement is illegal or unenforceable, it may be severed from this Agreement and the remaining provisions of this Agreement shall continue to remain in force.
- 19. The Parties are independent contracting parties and will have no power or authority to assume or create any obligation or responsibility on behalf of each other. This Agreement will not be construed to create or imply in any manner, any partnership, agency, trust, joint venture, or employer-employee relationship between the Parties.

- 2. This registration shall be valid for a period of five (5) years from the date of issuance of this PRO Registration.
- 3. The registered PRO shall maintain information related to its toll free numbers, customer care numbers, list of dismantlers, list of recyclers, list of its collection centres, list of collection points and details of its reverse logistic partners (transporters) along with their contact details on its web sites www.saahaszerowaste.com
- 4. The registered PRO shall maintain records of e-waste and make such records available for scrutiny by Central Pollution Control Board as and when required.
- 5. The registered PRO shall file annual returns to the Central Pollution Control Board on or before 30th day of June following every financial year.
- 6. The registered PRO shall comply with provisions of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, E-Waste (Management) Rules, 2016, E-Waste (Management) Amendment Rules, 2018, other applicable regulations and CPCB's guidelines issued from time to time under these rules.
- 7. An application for the renewal of registration shall be made before 60 days of its expiry.

8. The Central Pollution Control Board reserves right to cancel/amend/revoke the PRO registration at any time in case of any violation of the E-Waste (Management) Rules 2016 and amendments thereafter or CPCB's guidelines issued from time to time under these rules.

DEPARTMENT OF CHEMISTRY

GUIDELINES FOR CHEMICAL DISPOSAL

- Acids and Corrosive chemicals are nutralised with soda ash or sodium bicarbonate or alkali.
- Mixed organic solvents are separated by fractional distillations in the laboratory and reused depending on purity / suitability.
- 3. Broken glass wastes are collected separately and send for recycling.
- 4. Excess solutions in the lab are stored in containers and are to be reused.
- 5. Concentrated acids are diluted to 1:10 ratio with water and disposed.
- 6. Solid chemical wastes must be collected in poly bags separately and tie its mouth before disposal.
- 7. Don't mix unknown chemicals together at the time of disposal.
- 8. Water reactive materials (e.g. sodium) should be kept away from water sources.
- Solvents must be separately collected in plastic or metal containers, e.g. benzene, ether, ethyl acetate, acetone, alcohols, hydrocarbons, etc.
- 10. Non-toxic basic waste with a pH<10 can be disposed into the drain with copious amounts of water.
- 11. Fill all non-sharp solid waste in garbage bags. Please use high quality, thick garbage bags that don't tear easily. The filled bag must be tied off so that the waste cannot leak or spill out.
- 12. Before disposal ensure that the solvent wastes bottles/cans are tightly sealed



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
